CEDARWOOD ATLAS Lipio serum

A lipio serum is a regenerative preparation of a whole new kind. Thanks to its ingredients, it optimizes skin functions including the activity of sebaceous glands. It regenerates and softens the skin and may have anti-inflammatory properties. With regular application, over time, hyperpigmentation may even become lighter; it also protects the skin against UV radiation.

Due to cedarwood atlas oil, the preparation can be described as a special regenerative serum for oily skin. It may contribute to improving lymphatic circulation. It has a pleasant smell owing to its composition of essential oils. Given that oily skin tends to be prone to inflammation, we can also highlight its antibacterial, anti-inflammatory and soothing properties. It optimizes the functioning of sebaceous glands.

Main ingredients: Vegetable oils: borage, jojoba. Lecithin. Panthenol. Essential oils: chamomile, Atlas cedar, cypress, lemon balm, lavender. Vitamins E, A, F. Lactic acid. Distilled water.

Application: Apply 5–7 drops several times a day to skin previously treated with a face lotion or a toner. It is also suitable for application to the eye area. Gently rub in the emerging emulsion to the skin. Take care not to exert too much unnecessary pressure, which may disturb sensitive skin capillaries.

Warning: It is important to keep the bottle thread clean! Wipe off any residues to prevent micro-organism contamination. Shake before use.
