TAMANU DERM Regenerative balm

It's been a few years since I received a sample of a "miraculous" oil with the exotic-sounding name "Tamanu". Its Latin name is Calophyllum inophyllum. The oil is extracted from nut kernels. Its specificity is that apart from fat it has a high proportion of resins. It is little wonder that in the areas where it grows this tree is considered as holy, and its oil is used for skin problems and conditions. Its strength lies mainly in its anti-inflammatory and regenerative properties. Based on this oil, a preparation has been created which may be helpful in skin care where atopic dermatitis is concerned. People who have tried out the cream confirm its excellent regenerative effects and also the fact that after a short period of use the skin appears as if it has grown younger.

TAMANU-DERM has a thick consistency at room temperature, but it quickly softens up on application and becomes easily spreadable. From this point of view, it might probably be described as a intermediate product, half way between cream and balm. Suitable for normal to extremely dry skin.

Main ingredients: Vegetable fats and oils: almond, jojoba, wheat germ, shea butter. Lecithin. Emulsifiers. Vitamins. Beta-carotene, panthenol. Essential oils: tamanu, rose. Distilled water.

Application: Wash your face and apply the required amount of the regenerative cream on the skin, working it in gently. The skin is not shiny after application.

Information: To wash your face before applying the cream, it is advisable to use surfactant-free washing agents, since it is well known that surfactants deprive the skin of oil, drying it out. It is for this reason that soaps, even the liquid ones, are discouraged. Hydrophilic washing oils can be suggested as a better alternative.

INCI: Butyrospermum parkii Butter, Aqua, Calophyllum inophyllum Seed Oil, Carnauba Cera, Linum usitatissimum Seed Oil, Lanolin, Sorbitan Oleate, Urea, Panthenol, Lecithin, Cymbopogon citratus Leaf Oil, Borago officinalis Seed Oil, Oenothera biennis Oil, Tocopheryl acetate, Thymus vulgaris Flower/Leaf Oil, Retinyl palmitate, Lactic Acid, Daucus carota sativa Seed Oil, Beta-carotene, Rosa damascena Flower Oil, Salvia officinalis Oil, Lavandula hybrida Oil, Rosmarinus officinalis Leaf Oil, Eugenia caryophyllus Flower Oil, Citrus Iimon Peel Oil, Thymus serpyllum Oil, Piper nigrum Fruit Oil, Anthemis nobilis Flower Oil

Storage: The stated expiry date can be substantially extended by keeping the product in a dark and cold place (ideally in a fridge at 6–10 °C).

Best before the date indicated on the packaging. Batch number and volume are indicated on the packaging.
