For a long time, the catalog contained only shower oil and washing oil; now you have the chance to try the lemon balm regenerative cream. Lemon balm essential oil has a specific fragrance, fresh, similar to lemon. It's not unusual given that one of its main components is the aldehyde citral. This fact alone tells us that it will probably give out quite a fresh smell and have calming effects. Another major component is myrcene. This compound is a monoterpene hydrocarbon, calming the body extremely well, particularly the skin. There are other components present in small quantities such as nerol and geraniol, alcohols that give out a fragrance that can be described as rosy. Because of their low volume, the smell is almost indistinct. As a complex, lemon balm shows strong anti-inflammatory and antiviral effects.

Main ingredients: Shea butter, jojoba oil, almond oil, sesame oil and others, essential oils such as lemon balm, carrot seed and lavender, vitamins, and lecithin.

Application: Wash your face and apply the required amount of the regenerative cream on the skin and work in gently.

Information: It's worth pointing out that shortly after the lemon balm preparations entered the market, their outstanding effects were also noticed by people with atopic dermatitis. I think I will be right in saying that, as far as skin care is concerned, lemon balm products are one of the best things there are for people with atopic dermatitis.
