APISAN honey cream is a herbal regenerative cream which significantly softens the skin and boosts metabolic processes. It can be described as a luxurious skin care preparation for all skin types.

Honey has been known from time immemorial as a food that can make tea or pastry sweet, but also as a folk remedy used for colds, blocked nose, or the flu. Also known is its cleansing effect on various bleeding injuries such as scrapes. While foraging, bees come into contact with many medicinal plants whose active substances thus get into honey. Honey hasn't escaped the attention of the cosmetics industry either.

However, its implementation in commercial cosmetics is very difficult because by diluting it, we alter its original properties, turning it into sweet water rather than honey, although it preserves albeit in a diluted form everything that was originally in the honey. If you add an effective amount of honey into a cream, you will be like a flypaper once all water evaporates. This is the reason why the amount of honey being added tends to be just symbolic. But even such low sugar content represents a welcome nutrient for all sorts of yeasts and molds which have no place in a cosmetic product. Such a product invariably requires substantial chemical preservation against microbial contamination. The obvious negative impacts of preservative agents on the skin are well known. Aromatherapy provides a solution to this problem. The typical smell of honey is due to the essential oils that are one of the components of both honey and beeswax. In cooperation with companies that produce essential oils, a special technology has been devised for their extraction while separating them from sugars. Vegetable oils, as it's customary, are used in the production of the „honeyed“ APISAN cream.

**Main ingredients:** Vegetable oils: almond, jojoba, sesame, wheat germ, evening primrose, borage, shea butter, beeswax. Lecithin. Beeswax essential oil. Emulsifiers. Vitamins A, E, F, C. Beta-carotene, panthenol. Glycerin. Distilled water.

**Application:** Wash your face, apply the required amount of the herbal regenerative cream on the skin and work in gently. The skin is not shiny after application.

**Information:** To wash your face before applying the cream, we advise to use surfactant-free washing agents, since it is well known that surfactants deprive the skin of oil, drying it out. It is for this reason that soaps, even the liquid ones, are discouraged. Hydrophilic washing oils can be suggested as a better alternative.

**Storage:** The stated expiry date can be substantially extended by keeping the product in a dark and cold place (ideally in a fridge at 6–10 °C).
