They provide complex protection against negative environmental effects. Regenerative oils also provide long-lasting hydration.

Main ingredients: Vegetable oils: avocado, jojoba, walnut, borage, karité, almond. Lecithin. Essential oils: rosewood. Vitamins A, E, F.

Application: Having washed your face, apply a few drops of the oil on the moist complexion and gently massage the forming emulsion into the skin. Facial oils are very economical compared to creams – 30 ml of regenerative oil corresponds to 150 ml of a regular cream. The skin doesn't look oily after application. It is suitable for all skin types. The oils don't produce any adverse effects and are tolerated even by very sensitive skin.

Information: Regenerative facial oils have a protection factor of at least 2, which prevents premature skin aging due to ultraviolet radiation.
