## CHAMOMILE Lipio serum

A lipio serum is a regenerative preparation of a whole new kind. Its ingredients are known to optimize skin functions including sebaceous gland activity. They regenerate and soften the skin and have anti-inflammatory properties – regular application may also lighten hyperpigmentation; they protect against UV radiation.

The soothing and anti-inflammatory effects of chamomile are very well known much as its pleasant fragrance. Thanks to its skin elasticity-increasing properties, this regenerative preparation is ideal for all skin types. But it will be most appreciated by individuals with hypersensitive, red and inflamed, rash-ridden skin. The preparation may also be used to relieve the tired eye area. It doesn't make wonders, but it does provide effective help.

Main ingredients: Vegetable oils: borage, jojoba. Lecithin. Panthenol. Chamomile essential oil (blue). Vitamins E, A, F. Lactic acid. Distilled water.

**Note:** The preparation doesn't contain a chamomile extract but a high quality Egyptian chamomile essential oil. For this reason, the preparation can be used in most cases (varies from person to person) to calm extremely hypersensitive skin and also certain allergic reactions of the skin.

**Application:** Apply 5–7 drops several times a day to skin previously treated with a face lotion or a toner. It is also suitable for application to the eye area. Gently rub in the emerging emulsion to the skin. Take care not to exert too much unnecessary pressure, which may disturb sensitive skin capillaries.

**Warning:** It is important to keep the bottle thread clean! Wipe off any residues to prevent micro-organism contamination. Shake before use.

INCI: Aqua, Lecithin, Simmondsia chinensis Seed Oil, Tocopheryl acetate, Borago officinalis Seed Oil, Panthenol, Urea, Chamomilla recutita Flower Oil, Glycerin, Lactic Acid, Retinyl palmitate, Rosa damascena Flower Oil, Lavandula hybrida Oil, Thymus serpyllum Oil, Piper nigrum Fruit Oil, Eugenia caryophyllus Flower Oil, Rosmarinus officinalis Leaf Oil, Salvia officinalis Oil, Thymus vulgaris Flower/Leaf Oil, Citrus limon Peel Oil, Xanthan gum

Storage: The stated expiry date can be substantially extended by keeping the product in a dark and cold place (ideally in a fridge at 6–10°C).

Best before the date indicated on the packaging. Batch number and volume are indicated on the packaging.
