LECINOS contains special essential oils which are known for their effect on swelling, so it can be used for treating this condition, too. It is a lecithin emulsion which moistens the mucosa and it can also optimize its functions. It also contains essential oils which have antimicrobial effects. And here it is worth mentioning the contained vitamins, too.

It can happen that after the first application of the product you can feel certain burning in your nose for a while. This can naturally happen if the mucosa is a little injured. However, this manifestation disappears after the mucosa has healed over a short period of time.

Application: Apply 1–2 drops of the balm in and around the nostrils when necessary. Not suitable for children under 3 years! Refrigerate after opening. Best before date indicated on the packaging.

Mr. Hadek's recommendation: Apply the preparation with applicator – spray – in the nose. When necessary, it can be applied even several times a day. Unlike many medicaments offered by pharmacy, LECINOS doesn't contain any potentially addictive substances. I wouldn't recommend LECINOS for small children. The mentioned burning in the nose would certainly lead to many loud objections.

Main ingredients: Vegetable oils: almond, jojoba, soybean. Essential oils: lavender, rosemary, chamomile, mint. Water, lecithin, vitamins A and E, beta-carotene.

Storage: The stated expiry date can be substantially extended by keeping the product in a dark and cold place (ideally in a fridge at 6–10 °C).

Best before the date indicated on the packaging. Batch number and volume are indicated on the packaging.
