Main ingredients: Vegetable oils: jojoba, walnut, borage, almond. Lecithin. Essential oils: geranium. Vitamins A, E, F.

Application: Having washed your face, apply a few drops of the oil on the moist complexion and gently massage the forming emulsion into the skin. Facial oils are very economical compared to creams – 30 ml of regenerative oil corresponds to 150 ml of a regular cream. The skin doesn't look oily after application. It is suitable for all skin types.
