Aloe vera is in vogue these days. It has justly found its way to the realm of cosmetics. Aloe vera has a very interesting, beautiful nickname – desert lily. Our ALOE VERA cream is a little different from other such labelled preparations. Most aloe creams are marketed as moisturizing creams. With its polysaccharide content, aloe vera easily lends itself for such purpose as polysaccharides are hygroscopic. As active ingredients, this cream contains a balanced ratio of both aloe vera oil macerate and juice, making it contain as a result less water and more aloe macerate, shea butter, and vegetable oils and wax. Owing to these components, it has a thicker consistency at a room temperature. After applying it on the skin and warming up, it is, however, very easily spreadable. Regarding its effects, we can say that the preparation is soothing to the skin, and so it is suitable for normal to very sensitive skin. Thanks to its active ingredients, it makes the skin wonderfully soft and supple, meaning that it seems like an option also for mature skin. It might also be worth quoting a few clients who claim that the ALOE VERA cream will, to some extent, lighten up hyperpigmentation when used long term. This means that a regular and long term use of the cream improves the overall condition of the skin. It not only contributes to the regeneration of the skin, but, in addition, it protects it quite well from excessive water loss.

**Main ingredients:** Vegetable oils and fats: almond, soybean, shea butter, beeswax. Aloe vera. Emulsifiers. Vitamins: A, E, F. Panthenol. Lactic acid. Distilled water.

**Application:** Wash your face and apply the required amount of the regenerative cream on the skin, working it in gently. The skin is not shiny after application.

**Information:** To wash your face before applying the cream, we advise to use surfactant-free washing agents, since it is well known that surfactants deprive the skin of oil, drying it out. It is for this reason that soaps, even the liquid ones, are discouraged. Hydrophilic washing oils can be suggested as a better alternative.

**Storage:** The stated expiry date can be substantially extended by keeping the product in a dark and cold place (ideally in a fridge at 6–10 °C).
